The Whiteley PTA is open to all volunteers and welcomes all of our families to participate. Our PTA provides support for activities at our school for the benefit of our children.

What Do We Do With the Money?

PTA programs are integrated into every aspect of the Whiteley student's day. PTA sponsors curriculum based and cultural programs.

Below is a list of things we do during the day and after the school day.

During school:

Assemblies, Kindergym, Kindergym Olympics, Box Top Parties, Twice a Month Popcorn to Classrooms, School Pictures, Teacher Luncheon, Ice Cream Truck for Field Day and 6th Grade Picnic.

Before and/or After school:

Lastly, we provide approximately \$4,500 to teachers as classroom support annually.

How can I get involved?
